## Procurement Process

Once flexibility requirements have been identified, the following steps are followed to procure the necessary services:

| PROCESS STEP | Description | Where | Timescale |
| :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| STEP 1 - Signposting | Intention to tender and timeline are published | Flexible Power website | At least 1 month before |
| STEP 2 - Issue of ITT | Invitation to Tender plus Flexibility Requirements are published | Flexible Power website and Tender Platform |  |
| STEP 3 - Pre-qualification | a) Company pre-qualification assessment of company specific data uploaded to the DPS <br> b) Asset pre-qualification assessment of asset uploaded to confirm location, technical compliance etc. | Tender Platform | Ongoing until prequalification deadline (set 3 weeks before bidding opens) |
| STEP 4 - Technical <br> Assessment | Assessment of pre-qualified companies and assets for each CMZ. This will confirm if sufficient capacity has prequalified for CMZ to progress to tender. | SPEN assessment | 3 weeks |
| STEP 5 - Bidding Window | Bidding window opened for each CMZ progressed to competitive tender | Tender Platform | 1 week |
| STEP 6 - Bid Assessment | Assessment of bids received as per Bid Assessment criteria. | SPEN assessment | 6 weeks |
| STEP 7 - Accept Bids | Bids accepted / rejected. | Tender Platform |  |
| STEP 8 - Contract Award | Flexibility Services Agreement completed. |  | As soon as possible after accepted bid. |

The detailed process is included in Appendix 1.
Once the Flexibility Services Agreement has been fully executed, the Provider will be on-boarded to Flexible Power in preparation for providing the service.
